Council Bill 50-2018 - AN ACT pursuant to Section 612 of the Howard County Charter, approving a multi-year Lease Agreement between Howard County, Maryland and CDW-G, LLC, for the lease of multi-function copiers; and authorizing the County Executive to take certain actions in connection with the Lease Agreement. (*Expires 9/05/18; 10/05/18 if extended; or 11/04/18 if extended twice.*)

Council Bill 51-2018 - AN ACT pursuant to Section 612 of the Howard County Charter, approving a Lease Agreement between Howard County, Maryland and NewTower Trust Company Multi-Employer Property Trust for the lease of space located at 6095 Marshalee Drive, Elkridge, Maryland; and authorizing the County Executive to take certain actions in connection with the Lease Agreement. Council Bill 53-2018 - AN ACT pursuant to Section 612 of the Howard County Charter, approving a Lease Agreement between Howard County, Maryland and 9200 Berger Business Trust for the lease of space located at 9200 Berger Road, Columbia, Maryland; and authorizing the County Executive to take certain actions in connection with the Lease Agreement. Council Resolution 113-2018 - A RESOLUTION endorsing the provision of financing by the State Department of Commerce for an economic development project in Howard County and certifying that the project is consistent with the County's plan for economic development. (*No expiration date*)

Council Bill 57-2018 – Introduced by: Jon Weinstein - AN ACT providing for credit in the Howard County Police and Fire Employees' Retirement Plan for pre-employment military service in certain situations; specifying the conditions and forms of proof; and generally relating to Howard County police and fire pension plans. (Expires 9/05/18; 10/05/18 if extended; or 11/04/18 if extended twice.)

Council Resolution 118-2018 - AN ACT declaring that a total of approximately 1,312 square feet of real property with the reservation for an Underground Storm Water Management facility in Ellicott City is no longer needed for a public purpose and authorizing the County Executive to waive the advertising and bidding requirements of Section 4.201 of the Howard County Code in order to convey the County's property interest to the adjacent property owner. (*No expiration date*)

Council Bill 55-2018 – Introduced by: Jennifer Terrasa and Calvin Ball - AN ACT repealing the mobile home site rental tax; and generally relating to mobile home developments. (Expires 9/05/18; 10/05/18 if extended; or 11/04/18 if extended twice.)

Council Bill 58-2018 – Introduced by: Calvin Ball and Jennifer Terrasa - AN ACT amending the Howard County Code to amend the requirements for new developments on Scenic Roads; and generally relating to Scenic Roads. (Expires 9/05/18; 10/05/18 if extended; or 11/04/18 if extended twice.)

Council Bill 59-2018 – Introduced by: The Chairperson at the request of Erickson Living Properties II, LLC - AN ACT amending the General Plan for Howard County ("PlanHoward 2030") by adjusting the Planned Service Area boundary for water and sewer service to include approximately 61 acres of property located west of Clarksville Pike (MD Route 108) and south of Sheppard Lane, in Clarksville, Howard County, Maryland; to adjust the Growth Tier Maps of Howard County to reflect the incorporation of said property into the Planned Service Area and the designation of said property within the Growth Tier 1 area of Howard County; and further designating said property as a Targeted Growth and Revitalization Designated Place Type; and providing that certain adjustments will be null and void unless certain conditions are met; and generally relating to PlanHoward 2030. (Expires 9/05/18; 10/05/18 if extended; or 11/04/18 if extended twice.)

Council Bill 54-2018 - AN ACT pursuant to Section 612 of the Howard County Charter, approving a multi-year Project Agreement for the Design, Construction, Financing, Operation and Maintenance of the Howard County Circuit Courthouse between Howard County, Maryland and a special purpose entity formed by Edgemoor-Star America Judicial Partners for the design, construction, partial financing, operation and maintenance of a new Courthouse and related Parking Structure to be located on the Project Site located at 9250 Judicial Way (formerly known as 9240 and 9250 Bendix Road) in Ellicott City; authorizing the County Executive to enter into the Agreement and to make changes to the Agreement before executing it, under certain conditions; and generally relating to a multi-year agreement for the design, construction, financing, operation and maintenance of the Howard County Circuit Courthouse. (Expires 9/05/18; 10/05/18 if extended; or 11/04/18 if extended twice.)

Council Bill 56-2018 - Introduced by: Jon Weinstein and Cosponsored by Calvin Ball, Jennifer Terrasa, Greg Fox and Mary Kay Sigaty - AN ACT temporarily prohibiting issuance of certain permits and certain approvals of development plans and zoning changes for property that drains in whole or in part to the Tiber Branch Watershed in Howard County to study flooding events that threaten public health, safety, and welfare; requesting the Department of Planning and Zoning, the Department of Public Works, and other County agencies to study past, present, and future land uses, drainage infrastructure, storm water management, and flood mitigation, and all other factors related to flooding in the Tiber Branch Watershed, and report and make recommendations on changes to land uses, drainage infrastructure, stormwater management, and flood mitigation; defining certain terms; providing certain exemptions from the Act; providing that this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect after a certain period; and generally relating to

land use, storm water management, drainage and flood mitigation; and declaring this to be an emergency Act. (Expires 9/05/18; 10/05/18 if extended; or 11/04/18 if extended twice.)

Council Resolution 119-2018 - Introduced by: Greg Fox – A RESOLUTION approving an amendment to the Howard County Master Plan for Water and Sewerage. (*No expiration date*)

Council Resolution 71-2018 - A RESOLUTION confirming the appointment of David Drasin to the Multimodal Transportation Board. (tabled 7/2/18) (*No expiration date*)

Council Bill 39-2018 - Introduced by: Jon Weinstein - AN ACT requiring specified shelter and conditions for certain dogs at certain times; specifying how dogs may be tethered, authorizing the Animal Control Officer to issue certain animal safety alerts in a specified manner; requiring certain publicity of certain provisions of Title 17 Subtitle 3; providing for civil penalties for specified violations; and generally relating to animal control in Howard County. (tabled 7/2/18) (*Expires 8/08/18; 9/07/18 if extended; or 10/07/18 if extended twice.*)

Council Bill 44-2018 – Introduced by: The Chairperson - AN ACT modifying the Howard County Public Ethics Law by clarifying that "interest" does not include owning or holding an exchange-traded fund; specifying who must file financial disclosure statements; prohibiting certain lobbying by specified former officials related to legislation before the County Council for a specified period; altering certain disclosure requirements; requiring the Howard County Ethics Commission to redact certain home addresses from specified documents disclosed to the public; repealing the prohibition related to participating in County procurement if a certain contingency is met; and generally relating to the Howard County Public Ethics Law. (tabled 7/2/18) (*Expires 8/08/18*; 9/07/18 if extended; or 10/07/18 if extended twice.)

Council Bill 45-2018 – Introduced by: The Chairperson - AN ACT prohibiting participation in specified County bidding by persons who have participated in specified activities related to assisting the County in developing the purchasing specifications, invitations, or requests for proposals; and generally relating to the Howard County Purchasing Law. (tabled 7/2/18) (*Expires 8/08/18; 9/07/18 if extended; or 10/07/18 if extended twice*.)

Council Resolution 82-2018 - A RESOLUTION adopting the Housing Unit Allocation Chart for Fiscal Year 2019 pursuant to the Adequate Public Facilities Act of Howard County. (tabled 7/2/18) (*No expiration date*)

Council Resolution 83-2018 - A RESOLUTION adopting the School Capacity Chart, pursuant to the Adequate Public Facilities Act of Howard County, to designate the school

regions, elementary schools, and middle schools constrained for new residential development during each of the following years as based on the definition of program capacity as defined by Howard County Public School System policy. (tabled 7/2/18) (*No expiration date*)

Council Resolution 112-2017 - A RESOLUTION amending the green neighborhood standards that are used to qualify for Green Neighborhood Allocations and amending a total number of possible points on the Green Neighborhood Site portion of the Green Neighborhood Checklist. Council Resolution 1-2017 – Introduced by the Chairperson at the request of Windsor Forest Fox Chasing HOA, Inc. and Gaither Hunt Homeowners Association, Inc.; A RESOLUTION to close all of Winter Thicket Road, as shown in Exhibits A and B, in accordance with Section 18.204 of the Howard County Code. (tabled 2/6/17) (*No expiration date*.)

Council Resolution 179-2016 – Introduced by Calvin Ball and Jennifer Terrasa; A RESOLUTION calling on the Maryland State Department of Education to contract for a performance audit of the Howard County Public School System and specifying the issues requested to be studied. (tabled 12/05/16) (*No expiration date*.)

Council Resolution 104-2016 – A RESOLUTION pursuant to Section 4.201 of the Howard County Code, authorizing the County Executive's sale of certain real property known as the "Flier Building" owned by Howard County, Maryland, containing approximately 2.159 acres, and located at 10750 Little Patuxent Parkway, Maryland; waiving the advertising and bidding requirements of Section 4.201 of the Howard County Code; and providing that the County Executive is not bound to sell the property if he finds that it may have a further public use.
