- Council Bill No. 55-2013 AN ACT repealing certain temporary use provisions that are inconsistent with the Howard County Zoning Regulations; making certain technical corrections; and generally relating to the Howard County Zoning Regulations.
- Council Resolution No 167-2013 A RESOLUTION pursuant to Sections 16.301 and 16.200(a) of the Howard County Code, granting a variance for government uses from the structure and use setback for an addition to the front of Deep Run Elementary School.
- Council Resolution No 168-2013 A RESOLUTION pursuant to Sections 16.301 and 16.200(a) of the Howard County Code, granting a variance for government uses from the structure and use setback for a proposed athletic field and fence at Troy Park

- Council Resolution No 170-2013 A RESOLUTION pursuant to Section 4.201 of the Howard County Code declaring that a portion of a Sewer Easement comprising approximately 0.0893 acres is no longer needed by Howard County, Maryland for public purposes; authorizing the County Executive to terminate the property interest, vesting title to the underlying property owner, RHEES Hanover, LLC; and waiving the advertising and bidding requirements of Section 4.201 of the Howard County Code; and providing that the County Executive is not bound to abandon the easement if he finds that the easement may have a further public use.
