FINAL CONSIDERATION

Council Bill 28-2021 - AN ACT making emergency appropriations pursuant to Section 610(b) of the Howard County Charter and amending the Annual Budget and Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2021 in order to receive additional grant funding from the State; and declaring that this Act is an Emergency Bill necessary to meet a public emergency affecting life, health or property. (*Expires 7/12/21; 8/16/21 if extended; or 9/20/21 if extended twice.*)
