- Council Bill No. 43-2013 Introduced by: Calvin Ball, Councilperson Requiring the Department of Housing and Community Development to include certain additional information in the annual moderate income housing unit analysis the Department is required to file; requiring that the analysis be filed by a certain date; and generally relating to moderate income housing units.
- Council Bill No. 44-2013 (ZRA 146) Amending the Howard County Zoning Regulations to allow certain farm breweries as an accessory use in certain Zoning Districts and subject to certain criteria; and generally relating to the Howard County Zoning Regulations.
