- Supplementary Budget & Appropriation Ordinance No. 1-FY2013 Transferring \$10,006 from the Grants Fund, Contingency Reserve to the Sheriff's Office for a grant to provide overtime funding for deputies assigned to the Domestic Violence Unit.
- Supplementary Budget & Appropriation Ordinance No. 2-FY2013 Transferring \$307,980 from the Grants Fund, Contingency Reserve to the Department of Technology and Communication Services for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grants Program.
- Council Bill No. 32-2012 authorizing the issuance, sale and delivery of up to \$100,000,000 consolidated public improvement bonds and up to \$10,000,000 metropolitan district bonds, pursuant to various bond enabling laws; providing that such bonds shall be general obligations of the County; authorizing the County Executive to specify, prescribe, determine, provide for or approve the final principal amounts, maturity schedules, interest rates and redemption provisions for such bonds, and other matters, details, forms, documents or procedures and to determine the method of sale of such bonds; providing for the disbursement of the proceeds of such bonds and for the levying of taxes to pay debt service on such bonds; and providing for and determining various matters in connection therewith.

- Council Bill No. 28-2012 Introduced by Jennifer Terrasa, Cosponsored by Calvin Ball Establishing a tax credit against the County tax imposed on real property equipped with certain types of accessibility features, under certain conditions; establishing the amount, terms, conditions, and duration of the credit; providing for an application procedure and administration of the credit; and generally relating to property tax credits.
- Council Bill No. 29-2012 Pursuant to Section 612 of the Howard County Charter, approving a second amendment and new equipment schedule to 2009 Energy Performance Contract Master Lease-Purchase Agreement between Howard County, Maryland and Grant Capital Management, Inc., to refinance certain energy saving capital improvements originally financed thereunder.
- Council Bill No. 30-2012 Amending the on-site sewage disposal permit to include the modification, alteration, repair or connection to certain types of disposal systems; and generally relating to sewage disposal permits.
- Council Bill No. 31-2012 (ZRA 139) Introduced by, The Chairperson at the request of the Marsha S. McLaughlin, Director, Department of Planning and Zoning Amending the Howard County Zoning Regulations to require a financial affordable housing obligation or the provision of moderate income housing units in Downtown Columbia; and generally relating to the Howard County Zoning Regulations.
- Council Resolution No. 133-2012 Introduced by The Chairperson Calling the County Council of Howard County, Maryland into legislative session on September 18, 2012.
- Council Resolution No. 134-2012 Introduced by, Courtney Watson, Cosponsored by Calvin Ball and Jennifer Terrasa Requesting the Public Service Commission of Maryland investigate the reliability of the electric power supply for certain areas in Howard County and require electrical utility providers doing business in Howard County to disclose outage information to Howard County after 24 hours; and directing certain other actions by certain County officials.
- Council Resolution No. 135-2012 Adopting the 2012 Howard County Land Preservation & Recreation Plan.

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Council Resolution No. 136-2012 - Approving the 2011 Amendment to the Howard County Master Plan for Water and Sewerage, consisting of text, tables, and maps incorporating various revisions based on and including:

- 1. An analysis of the water and sewerage systems, including systems expansion to serve presently undeveloped areas within the Planned Service Area and augmentation of undersized existing facilities;
- 2. The progress of projects for future water supply and sewerage treatment needs in the county and outside of the county, including improvements to the Western Third Zone water supply and expansion of the Patapsco Wastewater Treatment Plant being built in coordination with Baltimore City and Baltimore County;
- 3. Review of service priorities for properties in the Planned Service Area; and
- 4. Changes in the anticipated alignment, location, and sizing of future facilities.
- Council Resolution No. 137-2012 Approving a revised schedule of fees for on-site sewage disposal functions regulated by the Health Department.
- Council Resolution No. 138-2012 Approving the terms and conditions of a Payment in Lieu of Taxes Agreement by and between Colonial LLLP and Howard County, Maryland for a senior rental housing project known as Park View at Colonial Landing.
- Council Resolution No. 139-2012 Approving the acquisition and renovation of an affordable housing project known as Park View at Colonial Landing in Elkridge, Maryland to be financed either directly by the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland or through the Department's Community Development Administration.
