**General**

**Council Bill 42-2022** - AN ACT making emergency appropriations pursuant to Section 610(b) of the Howard County Charter and amending the Annual Budget and Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2022 to provide additional spending authority in the Fleet Fund due to significant fuel cost increases; and declaring that this Act is an Emergency Bill necessary to meet a public emergency affecting life, health or property. (Expires 8/15/22; 9/19/2022 if extended; or 10/24/22 if extended twice)
