FINAL CONSIDERATION

General

Council Bill 11-2022 – Introduced by: Opel Jones, Deb Jung, Christiana Rigby, Liz Walsh, David Yungmann; Co-sponsored by: The Chairperson at the request of the County Executive - AN ACT repealing a certain provision of law relating to the determination of whether an election is contested for the distribution of a public contribution from the Citizens’ Election Fund; confirming that a certified candidate may receive a matching public contribution for any qualifying contributions that were collected prior to the effective date of this Act; making a technical correction in order to remove an ambiguity in the Citizens’ Election Fund law to facilitate orderly administration of the program; generally relating to the Citizens’ Election Fund; and declaring that this Act is an Emergency Bill necessary to meet a public emergency affecting life, health or property.

The Chairperson moved to approve Council Bill 11-2022. The motion was seconded by Mr. Yungmann.
