## CB48-2024 - Introduced by Liz Walsh

Short Title: Inspector General – Companion Legislation and Code Revisions *Title:* AN ACT supporting the creation of the Office of the Inspector General; amending the process for whistleblower complaints; repealing certain duties of the County Auditor; amending the composition of the Howard County Ethics Commission; and relating to supporting the Office of the Inspector General. expires – 09/09/2024; extended – 10/15/2024; extended twice – 11/18/2024

Chair Jung opened the session and started the discussion around establishing an independent Inspector General (IG) position for Howard County Government. The Council discussed various aspects of the proposed legislation, including candidate selection, termination procedures, and citizen board responsibilities. David McClintock provided the Council with suggestions, and recommendations on best practices in establishing an IG Office. A consensus was reached on various aspects of Howard County Code requirements for the Inspector General, the Citizen

The Council recognized the importance of diverse perspectives, debated whether the citizen board should or should not reflect political affiliation requirements while agreeing on criteria disqualifying individuals from board membership. The Council planned to incorporate all discussed elements into draft legislation for pre-filing, to solidify the roles and oversight processes necessary for the IG office.
