Council Bill No. 57-2009 – To authorize and empower Howard County, Maryland to borrow, on its full faith and credit, up to \$18,000,000 from the Maryland Water Quality Financing Administration (the "Administration"), and to issue and sell its installment bonds to the Administration, the proceeds thereof to be used to pay costs of Capital Project No. S6245 (Nitrogen Loading Reduction), as described in the County's 2010 Capital Budget, and to pay all related costs; and to levy taxes upon the assessable property within the County sufficient, together with benefit assessments, ad valorem taxes levied upon assessable property in the Metropolitan District and other available funds, to pay the debt service on such bonds; authorizing the County to enter into one or more Loan Agreements with the Administration to effect and further evidence such borrowing; and making certain findings and determinations

Supplementary Budget & Appropriation Ordinance No. 8-Fiscal 2010 – Transferring \$2,601,580 from the Grants Fund, Contingency Reserve to the Department of Technology and Communication Services for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant
