Appointments

Council Resolution No. 131-2008 – Confirming the appointment of Christina Diaz-Malone to the Board to Promote Self-Sufficiency (Tabled 1/5/09)

Council Resolution No. 132-2008 – Confirming the appointment of Sierra Harris to the Human Rights Commission (Tabled 1/5/09)

Financial

Supplementary Budget & Appropriation Ordinance No. 5-Fiscal 2009 – Transferring \$100,000 from the Grants Fund, Contingency Reserve to the Office of Workforce Development to provide funding for the “Working for Independence, Success and Healthy Families” program

Supplementary Budget & Appropriation Ordinance No. 6-Fiscal 2009 – Transferring \$38,864 from the Grants Fund, Contingency Reserve to the Department of Corrections for the State Criminal Alien Assistance Program

General

Council Bill No. 2-2009 – Amending an uncodified section in Council Bill No. 14-2007, as amended by Council Bill No. 11-2008, that required certain connections to the Planned Service Area for water and sewer within a certain time in order to extend the time to make the connections, and providing for the application of this Act

Council Bill No. 3-2009 (ZRA 104) - Amending the Howard County Zoning Regulations to amend certain definitions related to setbacks; to amend certain setbacks from amenity areas in the Corridor Employment Zoning Districts; to add certain setbacks from Route 1 in the Corridor Activity Center Zoning District; to amend certain setbacks from certain principal structures in the Transit Oriented Development; to require that certain developments include an amenity area; and generally related to the Howard County Zoning Regulations.

Council Bill No. 4-2009 (ZRA-103) – Introduced by The Chair at the request of Horse Farm, LLC and Deep Run Property Management, LLC - Amending the Howard County Zoning Regulations to allow developments utilizing the PSC zoning district overlay to also utilize the provisions of the underlying zoning district; add the PSC zoning district to the list of overlay districts found in the overlay district definition; and generally relating to the PSC zoning district

Council Bill No. 5-2009 (ZRA-106) – Introduced by The Chair at the request of James R. Buch and Robert M. Buch - Amending the Howard County Zoning Regulations' CAC zoning district to add a provision to permit apartment and single-family attached uses within a Route 1 Corridor development project of less than two acres, if the property is contiguous to a CAC development which has received an approved sketch plan or site development plan, under certain circumstance; and generally relating to the CAC zoning district

Council Bill No. 6-2009 (ZRA-107) – Introduced by The Chair at the request of Robert and Maxine Walker - Amending the Howard County Zoning Regulations' Limited Outdoor Social Assemblies conditional use to alter the road access requirement for Limited Outdoor Social Assemblies; and generally relating to the Limited Outdoor Social Assemblies conditional use

Council Resolution No. 1 -2009 – Amending Volume III (Roads and Bridges) of the Design Manual in order to clarify the intersection sight distance requirements, to clarify how stopping sight distance shall be measured, to clarify certain waivers, to clarify information required to request a waiver, and generally related to Volume III (Roads and Bridges) of the Design Manual

Council Resolution No. 2-2009 – Pursuant to the Howard County Cable Televisions Systems Franchise Act, granting a secondary cable franchise agreement to Ellicott City Cable Company, LLC for Taylor Village under certain terms and conditions

Council Resolution No. 3-2009 – Pursuant to the Howard County Cable Televisions Systems Franchise Act, granting a secondary cable franchise agreement to Ellicott City Cable Company, LLC for Waverly Woods under certain terms and conditions

Council Resolution No. 4-2009 – Endorsing the provision of financing by the State Department of Business and Economic Development for an economic development project in Howard County; designating the Howard County Economic Development Authority as the agency to administer the project; and certifying that the project is consistent with the County's plan for economic development

Council Resolution No. 5-2009 – Introduced by Greg Fox/Co-sponsored by Calvin Ball - Exempting certain hot air balloon activities from the admissions and amusement tax

Council Bill No. 1-2009 – Introduced by The Chairperson at the request of the County Executive/Co-sponsored by Calvin Ball, Greg Fox, Mary Kay Sigaty, and Jennifer Terrasa - Prohibiting the discharge of a gun within a certain distance from certain structures under certain conditions; prohibiting the discharge of a gun in the direction of certain structures; providing for certain exceptions; making certain technical corrections; defining certain terms; and generally related to firearm control provisions in the Howard County Code
