SAO1-FY2016 - AN ACT transferring \$68,260 from the Grants Fund, Contingency Reserve to the Department of Housing and Community Development to account for increased Community Development Block Grant funding.

Maxine Walker AN ACT amending the Howard County Zoning Regulations' Limited Outdoor Social Assemblies conditional use to permit the interior use of existing farm structures during events; and generally relating to Limited Outdoor Social Assemblies.
- Council Bill 40-2015 AN ACT approving and providing for a multi-year Installment Purchase Agreement by Howard County, Maryland to acquire development rights in approximately 29.38 acres of agricultural land located at 13945 Forsythe Road, Sykesville, Howard County, Maryland, from Our Forsythe, LLC, or any other owner thereof, for a maximum purchase price of \$635,400.00 or, if less, not more than \$21,625.60 per acre or portion thereof, rounded to the next highest \$100, plus interest on the deferred portion of such purchase price; providing that the County's obligation to pay such purchase price and interest on the deferred portion of such purchase price shall be a full faith and credit general obligation of the County; providing for the levying of taxes for such payments; authorizing the County Executive to modify such Agreement; and providing for and determining various matters in connection therewith.

- Council Bill 41-2015 AN ACT amending the Howard County Police and Fire Employees' Retirement Plan, Deferred Retirement Option Program II in order to clarify certain interest accruals for the Chief of Police and Chief of Fire and Rescue Services; providing that certain compensation amounts will be included in determining the average compensation for certain Chiefs under certain conditions; and generally relating to the Howard County Police and Fire Employees' Retirement Plan.
- Council Resolution 140-2015 Introduced by Mary Kay Sigaty; Co-sponsored by: Calvin Ball, Jennifer Terrasa and Jon Weinstein A RESOLUTION amending the Howard County Council Rules of Procedure to allow a Council Member to be added as a cosponsor at a certain time and in a certain manner; and generally relating to the Council Rules of Procedure.
- Council Resolution 141-2015 Introduced by: The Chairperson A RESOLUTION acknowledging receipt of the annual report of the Howard County Retirement Plan and the Police and Fire Employees' Retirement Plan submitted by the Pension Oversight Commission.
